
PUTTING LEEDS ON THE MAP

All of these pioneers have either lived or worked in Leeds and helped put the city on the map.


DR BRIAN BOFFEY

Invents solar powered fridge (2009).




JAMES HENRY ATKINSON

Designs successful Jenny Lind' locomotive (1847).




LOUIS AIMÉ AUGUSTIN LE PRINCE
