I will be greeted by a member of staff who will tell me where to go.



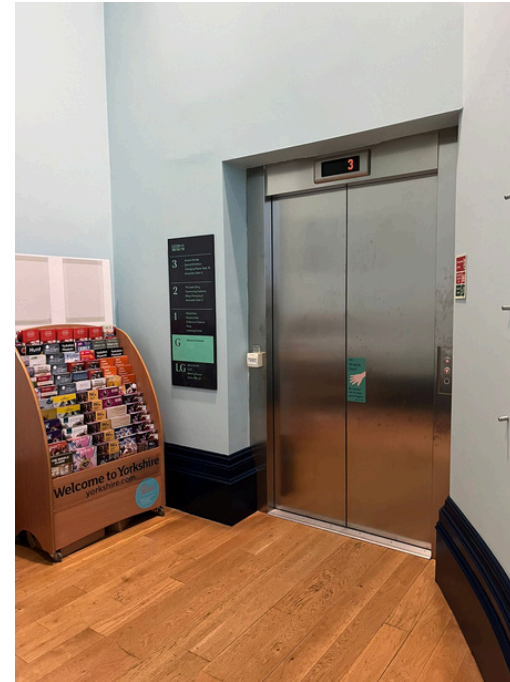
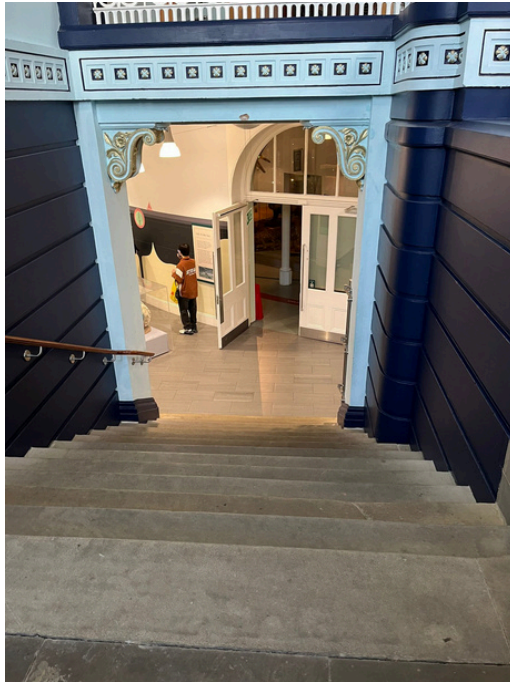
If I want to go to the toilet...



If I want to go to the toilet...



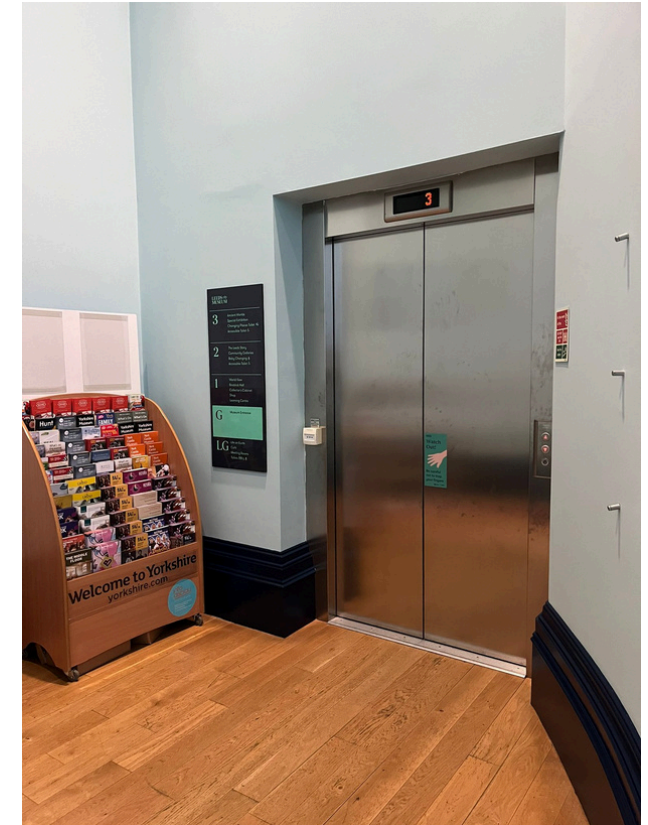
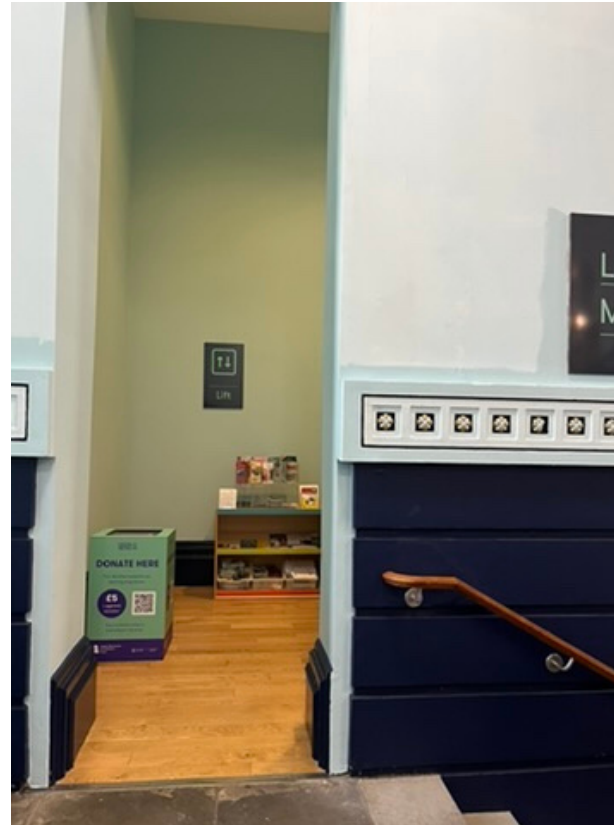
I can take the stairs or the lift to the Lower Ground Floor.

Broderick Hall.

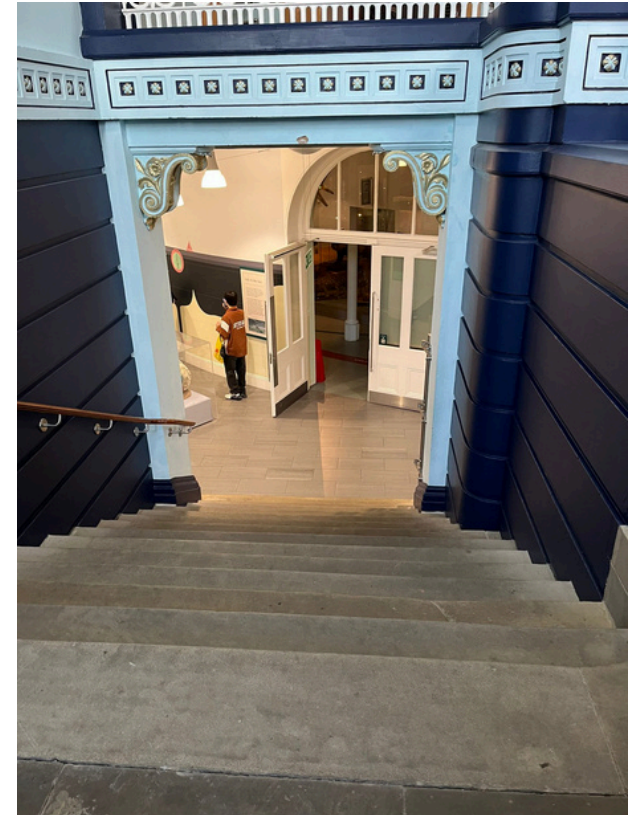
All the keynotes and spotlight talks will happen here. Half the workshops will happen here.

Broderick is a large space and speech can echo, we hope to ease this with live transcription.



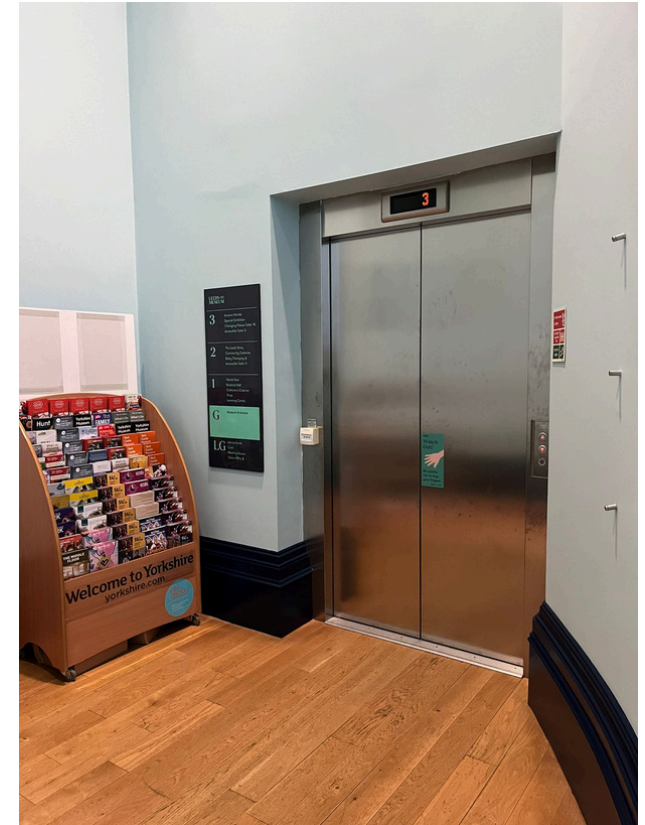
To get to the Thorsby room and quiet space.

archway

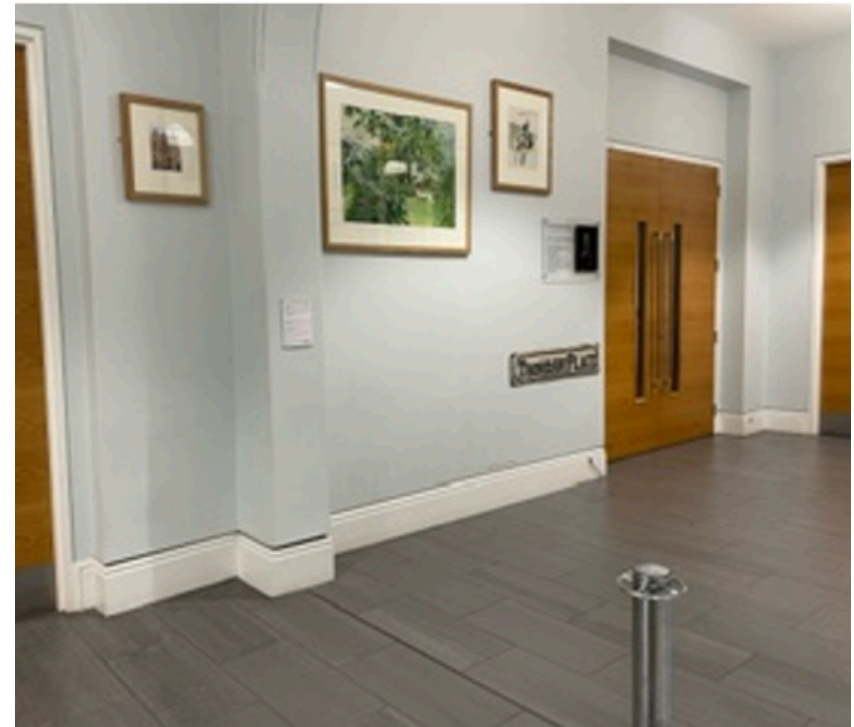


To get to the Thorsby room and Deny Room (quiet space).
