Enjoy a group visit to Lotherton and experience access, please contact us for more our charming Edwardian estate on the outskirts information. Accessible toilets and changing of Leeds.

Discover the history of the Gascoigne family who lived here, explore the vast grounds including our red deer park, and see animals from across the globe at Wildlife World. From the wealthy family that owned the estate, to the servants who worked here, Lotherton has been home to people since the 18th century. It is now preserved by Leeds Museums & Galleries as a museum and boasts collections including decorative arts, furniture and social history. Visitors can explore a series of enclosed gardens, designed by Mrs Gwendolen Gascoigne, which feature rose beds and herbaceous borders with scented flowers, tender creepers and perennials.
